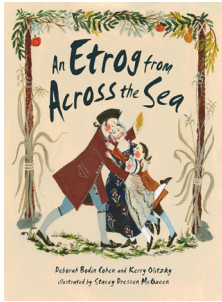

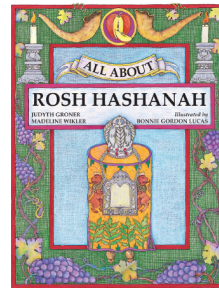


An Etrog from Across the Sea

Grandpapa Luis comforts Rachel with a beautiful silver etrog cup, but will her papa return in time for Sukkot, bringing the promised etrog?

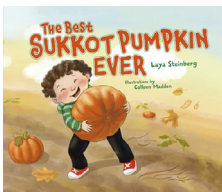

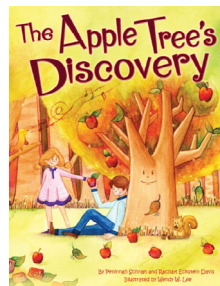


The Best Sukkot Pumpkin Ever

What will Micah decide to do with the best Sukkot pumpkin ever?

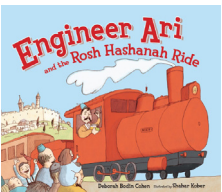

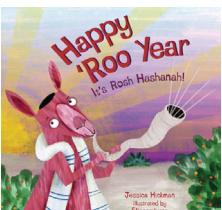

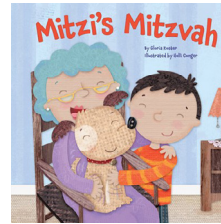

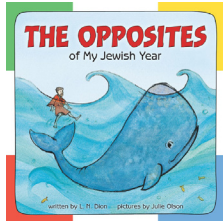

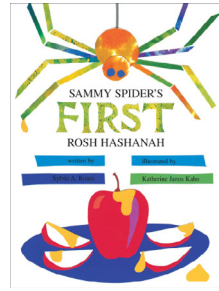

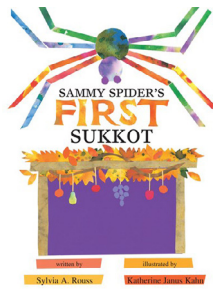
